## REFUNDS

**PARKING:** Horseboxes, trailers, and visitor cars should park sensibly in the main car park (hard standing). As a Livery Yard we have people coming and going throughout the day. Please leave car park clear of any litter – all dropping must be removed before you leave.

## COVID-19

We are all aware that restrictions are subject to change at any time – please adhere to current restrictions in place and Social Distancing guidelines when attending. In the interests of maintaining a safe environment we ask that:

- You do not come onto the main yard (only permitted for use of toilets)
- Once you have tacked up make your way round the track towards the menage. A member of staff will meet you.
- As far as possible only one groom/owner per horse/pony.
- As soon as you have jumped you return to your horsebox/trailer untack and leave the yard as quickly as possible.

- You use the warm-up arena provided (max. 6 people at any one time). Your helper/groom may do fences for you (please wear gloves).

### Information:

**You will be allowed 15 mins to warm-up in the menage before commencing the course.**

- There will be an optimum time for all Hunter Trial classes.
- Hunter Trial fences are all knock down. 10 penalties for a pole down. 15 penalties for a stop. We will try and get everyone round 😊.
- There will be an Option Fence within the HT course.
- Riders will be stopped if they are considered dangerous.
  - Correct dress must be worn by the competitor in Hunter Trial classes
  - Long hair should be secured appropriately
  - **Jewellery** can increase the risk of injury - competitors are advised to remove all jewellery and piercings (excl. wedding bands).
  - **HUNTER-TRIAL:** Competitors should wear a sweater or shirt ideally with long sleeves, white, buff or fawn breeches/jodhpurs and a body protector.

- Schooling Round at the same height as Class (after you have competed)
